- 1. WELCOME & APOLOGIES David Cox (Acting Chair) welcomed everyone to the meeting at Kettins Church Hall in John Smith's absence.
- 2. MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING: Draft Minute proposed by Joyce Falconer. Seconded by John Lyall.

#### 3. MATTERS ARISING

- a. Resilience Plan No date as yet rearranged to meet with SSEN. To carry forward.
- b. <u>Fete -</u> Twelve Stalls. Waiting on the Fire Brigade to confirm attendance. New additions: Archery and dog show confirmed. 5 Teachers will attend to help with bouncy castle as well as assisting with other stalls.
- c. Nature Restoration Fund Seed and tools (scythes and rake) have been purchased for wildflower meadow. Left to purchase: plug plants and habitat boxes. Wildflower area initial preparation done by rotavator, yet to till. Thanks to Mark Gow for organising the hire of the rotavator. Discussion into swift box location needs to be >5m in height with unobscured access to boxes. Suggestion was made to speak with Mike Ridell Webster about affixing to church. Open to other options. Deadline for completion extended to mid-lune
- d. <u>Litter Pick</u> Took place Saturday 6th April. Thanks to those who turned out, and to the Council who uplifted 7 bags of waste. A great deal of fly-tip waste remains along Newtyle Road between Kettins and Keillor Steadings. Possibility of organising another litter pick to tackle this.

- a) Police No police present. March update from Robbie Blackhall. 1 report of theft by housebreaking. Reminder to make residents aware of the Neighbourhood Watch scheme.

  - a. Colbeggie 100 MW BESS Public meeting at Kettins Hub, Wednesday 24th April 3-7pm drop-in.
  - b. Markethill Solar Reapplication Date for decision due May.
  - c. **Newhall** Developer communicated that there would be potable water brought into development site from hydrant by newtyle road bridge. Possibility of it crossing the wildflower meadow.
  - d. **Significant concerns** raised about proliferation of solar proposals in the vicinity. Concerns raised against their number, scale, and risk to public safety. Request for PKC councillors to lodge a note of disquiet.
