1. **WELCOME & APOLOGIES** John Smith welcomed everyone to the meeting at Kettins Church Hall. Thanks to Russell and Isobel chairing and minute cover.
2. **MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETINGS** 19<sup>th</sup> February 2026 carried forward for approval next month.
3. **MATTERS ARISING**
  - a) Fete – Susan Smith has stepped in to organise the entertainment. Mark will help on the day. next meeting Tuesday 24 February 2026 7 pm Kettins Hub. Blair pipe band £250 to play on the day. Meeting next week Tuesday 7 pm. Hoping to have costs finalised by the meeting, to be split three ways.
  - b) Community Consultation - Results to be shared with the CC.
  - c) Greenspace – Kettins Primary School pupils completed flower seed sowing 13th March. Two areas adjacent to the bench by Roseangle. Seed kindly provided by the developer at Newhall. War memorial grass verges to be returned to general maintenance.
4. **REPORTS**
  - a) **Police** – Police Commanders Bulletin, nothing in the area. Although, a robbery since at Scotmid on Commercial Street, Coupar Angus, March 16th. Police are hoping to be more proactive on speeding in the area.
  - b) **Treasurer** – no update.
  - c) **Planning** - Open drop-in at Red House Tuesday 24th March 2pm-7pm, re: pre-planning application on site selection on new 132kV substation at Coupar Angus.
  - d) **Perth & Kinross Councillors**

Councillor Stewart Full Council meeting: Tabled a motion to reverse decision around 1-5 high Street development, but was not passed. Council tax increase set at 8.9%. £15m investment in roads, over 3 years, with funds generated from borrowing.

Attended road safety meeting at Coupar Angus. Asked about Ardler Road, Greenburns section timetable to be reduced from 60 to 40 limit. Timescale for this not visible on the programme of works. Asked about the footpath between Coupar Angus and Kettins. To press for further updates on these.

Mean speed in villages (Balbeggie, Burrelton etc.) along A94 gradually coming down over the period since speed limits have come in across

Councillor Anderson - Licensing: extended opening hours during the world cup. Agreed there could be late openings for home nations games. Venues to be able to apply for licences to open until half an hour after full time for each of these games.

## 5. **CORRESPONDENCE**

- a) Temporary Road Closure A923 – 15th April for 2 weeks closed From The Access Road To Pitcur Farm To The Council Boundary West Of Lundie, Tullybaccart for carriage surfacing.

## 6. **ANY OTHER BUSINESS**

- a) DC attended a litter picking event at PKC Kettins Burn hosted by Keep Scotland Beautiful. Raised issue about A923. Was told that it was PKC responsibility. Make clear they did not want residents to be litter picking on the A roads. Date proposed TBC to get school involved. A resident asked who owned the burn. He has concerns about the burn and had a meeting with an engineer about his drains.
- b) Keillor Steadings defibrillator, a request to see if there is another opportunity to organise another training session. To look into contacting St John Ambulance about this, who did previous training.
- c) Hallyburton Estate to look into the full length of the burn as it runs through the estate with a view to assessing flood/resilience risk.
